Slide Piece: Greg Weissert's slider may be his ticket to the Bigs

Any night at the ballpark is worth your time, but it's especially true when walking into PNC Field in 2022. Sticking around until the bottom of the ninth is probably a good idea as you have the chance to see one of the best breaking balls in the Yankees' organization: Greg Weissert's slider.

Weissert has been used primarily as the closer for the RailRiders this season. The 27-year-old Fordham product jogs out of the left field bullpen ready to unleash his slider on the rest of the International League.

The slider is a breaking ball that typically sweeps across the strike zone in the opposite direction of a pitcher's throwing arm. It usually is thrown harder than a curveball so the initial flight path mimics a fastball to get hitters off-balance.

"I use it for everything. It's basically what I throw off of," he explained to me. His slider has been touted as the best in the Yankees organization by Baseball America.

Weissert started throwing a slider while playing college ball. But that wasn't the slider he is currently throwing. That's something he picked up during the 2019 Minor League season.

"I sat down one day, and I was like, you know, I don't have anything that stands out. I look around and all these guys have something that they do really, really well," he explained. "So, I sat down and started researching slider grips and whatnot. I went on Twitter and found Chaz Roe doing one of these interviews in the dugout and he was showing the reporter his slider grip. So I started throwing that."

Chaz Roe is a right-handed reliever who really made a name for himself with the Tampa Bay Rays. His slider is gawked at in the deep recesses of online pitching nerdism. From the publication Pitcher List to Rob Friedman aka Pitching Ninja, Roe's slider is in the upper echelon of reliever breaking pitches.

"I started with the slider, figured out how to just make it sweep, and then I added the two-seam off that. So I kind of built everything around [the slider]... It probably took like a month and a half of actually throwing it in games for it to get competitive." At one point, Weissert was throwing both his new and old slider. He made the decision one day that he had to lean in and take a chance on the new grip. It paid off.

"It was huge for my career in terms of giving me something that kind of could allow me to escape situations or get ahead and can be used in all different types of counts to righties and lefties."

The Yankees have clearly been one of the most dominant teams in the Majors in 2022, and a lot of it has to do with their elite pitching staff both starters and relievers. That success has rubbed off on their farm system. In Baseball America's Mid-Season Top-30 Prospects list for New York, 18 of them are pitchers.

The path to a new pitch for an arm in the Yankees system is not black and white. While working on what is going to best set up a pitcher for success in the organization, a back-and-forth occurs regularly.

“It’s more of a conversation, right?” Weissert said of how players work with staff. “I think it’s been really good here. There are a lot of people that understand a lot about the game and pitching especially with pitch design in particular.”

Pitch design is the latest and greatest way to craft a pitcher’s arsenal. It factors in a multitude of elements like delivery, arm slot, release, grip, follow through and even down to the minuscule movements of the fingers to see what will make a pitcher elite. High-speed cameras and other equipment are utilized to dissect the finite movements of a pitcher.

When it comes to Weissert’s slider, it spins at a rate of 2,800 to 3,000 revolutions per minute which according to RailRiders pitching coach Graham Johnson is higher than most in baseball. The pitch lives in the 80 to 83 MPH range.

Both pitchers who have been in the system for years or in their first season with New York have expressed how impressed they’ve been with how the staff goes about their business. While talking to many pitchers throughout the first half of the season with the RailRiders, nearly every single one of them has had only glowing reviews of how the Yankees develop and work with their arms.

Sam Briend is the Director of Pitching for the New York Yankees. Briend previously worked with Driveline Baseball, a data-driven baseball player development organization. Players like Clayton Kershaw and Shohei Ohtani and collegiate programs like Vanderbilt, Oregon State and Coastal Carolina all proudly have worked to implement Driveline’s philosophies. These philosophies are currently being used with the RailRiders and Yankees.

A new age of pitching is upon us. When reminiscing about elite arms of the past like Mariano Rivera, Nolan Ryan and Walter Johnson, one can only imagine what technology like this could have done for pitchers like that. Even down to the access to information, like in the case of Weissert’s slider, there’s a newfound appreciation for pitch types, grips and results across the baseball community. Remember, en route to developing the best slider in the system, it all started with a simple Twitter search from Greg Weissert.

Weissert’s big league dreams have yet to be realized. The former 18th-round pick has yet to make his Major League debut at the time of publication. He has not found himself on any top prospects list nor with any MiLB awards. Yet, it may be moot as he now has something in his tool belt that many others don’t.

The slider is his ultimate weapon, like a sword to a samurai or a fist to a boxer. It’s now the foundation of his entire pitching identity.

“It’s been the most important part of my arsenal.”

It might too be the most important part of his entire career.

MOOSIC, PA (July 14, 2022) –The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (42-45) downed the Louisville Bats 6-1 on Thursday night. Hayden Wesneski spun six scoreless frames en route to his fifth win of the season.

The RailRiders tagged number five Reds prospect Brandon Williamson for four runs in three innings. A two-run error was followed by a Max McDowell RBI double in the third to give the RailRiders their first lead. McDowell would walk in the third with the bases loaded to make it 4-0.

Oswald Peraza launched a long solo home run in the home half of the fourth against Louisville reliever Pedro Payano to extend the lead to 5-0. The homer tied Estevan Florial for the team lead, Peraza's eleventh.

Wesneski pitched true to form for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The righthander tossed six shutout innings, just as he did in his last outing against Worcester. The number five Yankees prospect according to Baseball America struck out six batters while surrendering just three hits. With the outing, he has now pushed his scoreless streak to 16.2 innings across three starts.

The two teams traded solo runs in the eighth inning. Peraza drove home another with a double to finish his night with a pair of RBIs. Zach Greene allowed the lone run of the game in two innings of relief. Greg Weissert lowered his ERA to 2.36 with a scoreless ninth. Wesneski (5-7) took the win with Williamson (1-2) taking the loss. The RailRiders take a 2-1 series lead and will need to win out the remainder of the series if they want to head to the All-Star break with a .500 record.

The RailRiders square off with Louisville on Friday for Margaritaville Night. The RailRiders will wear Margaritaville-inspired Hawaiian jerseys presented by Giant. These jerseys will be auctioned off to benefit the Children's Miracle Network. It's also First Responder Friday and Friday Night Fireworks, presented by NEPA Crane & Hauling and 98.5 KRZ. 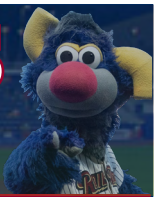

LAST TIME OUT

TOLEDO, OH (June 24, 2022) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders blanked the Toledo Mud Hens 2-0 behind dominant pitching. With 14 strikeouts from RailRiders pitching, they have now tallied 31 over the last 18 innings and 52 in the first four games of the series.

Ryan Weber was solid in his return to the RailRiders. The righty struck out four of the last five batters he faced, going 3.1 IP scoreless. Shane Greene followed suit with a pair of strikeouts, then Matt Krook finished the job. Krook retired all fifteen batters he faced from the start of the fifth to the end of the game. He struck out eight to set a new season-high.

Miguel Andújar got the RailRiders on the board with a no-doubt laser home run to left field to open the seventh. Estevan Florial doubled home Max McDowell from first in the eighth. That's all the offense Scranton/Wilkes-Barre would need to even the series at two games apiece, winning 2-0. It was the RailRiders seventh shutout win of the year and the fewest amount of hits they've allowed in any game this season, two.

Krook (3-6) would tally the victory in relief. Sam Howard (0-2) surrendered the Andújar homer and took the loss.

NEWS & NOTES

FIRST THINGS FIRST – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders are in Toledo, Ohio for the first time since May 19, 2019. They split a four-game series with the Toledo Mud Hens in that series. This six-game series is the only time these two teams meet this season. This is also currently the furthest Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has traveled this season. Fifth Third Field is 479 miles away from PNC Field.

HELLO-GOODBYE – Entering Saturday, seven of the last eight RailRiders pitchers have struck out the very first batter they have faced. The only exception is **Ryan Weber**. The list of successful first-batter strikeouts is **Ken Waldichuk, Zach Greene, Michael Gomez, Jimmy Cordero, Greg Weissert, Shane Greene** and **Matt Krook**.

K'S FOR DAYS – Over the course of the last two games (Friday-17 and Saturday-14), RailRiders pitching has struck out 31 Mud Hens. Strikeouts have accounted for 31-of-54 outs recorded in that span, or 57.41% of total outs. They have now struck out 52 batters in the series, which has accounted for 50.98% of the total number of outs recorded in four games (52/102).

TWO-ON-TWO – Entering Saturday, over the last ten games the RailRiders have either won two in a row or lost two in a row five separate times. This stretch began on June 14 against Rochester.

ROB CITY – **Rob Brantly** has been hot in this series in Toledo. The 32-year-old veteran is 5-for-8 in the set with three doubles, a walk and two RBI. To find five total hits for Brantly, you have to go back to May 7 tallying fifteen games played in with the RailRiders. Prior to these two multi-hit performances on Wednesday (three hits) and Thursday (two hits), Brantly had just one all season (two-hit game April 28 vs Lehigh Valley). 2022 is Brantly's second season with the RailRiders (68 games in 2021).

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT – **Miguel Andújar** is on a five-game hitting streak coming into play Saturday. This stretch matches a season-best, something he set June 9 to June 15. In the series, Andújar is 8-for-17 with a home run, double and two RBI. In the month of June he is slashing .365/.421/.558 with SWB with ten driven in, the most RBIs he's had in a single-month this season.

WIZARD OF OS – **Oswald Peraza** finds himself on a seven-game hitting streak and an eight-game on-base streak. The seven-gamer is a season-best, surpassing a six-game streak he set from April 28 to May 5. During this stretch, he is 12-for-30 (.400) with a pair of homers and a double. The last time Peraza did not tally a hit in a game was on June 10 against Syracuse. His career-best hit streak is eleven games which lasted from August 9 to August 21, 2019 while with the Charleston River Dogs (16-for-44, .364).

STREAKY – **Armando Alvarez** and **José Peraza** are on three-game hitting streaks...**Greg Bird** (5) and **Tim Locastro** (4) lost their hitting streaks Friday... **Zach Greene** has made six-straight scoreless appearances... **Greg Weissert** has made five-straight scoreless outings... **Jimmy Cordero** has four-straight scoreless outings (five of six games this season)...

SEVENTEEN AGAIN – The RailRiders tallied 17 hits as a lineup and 17 strikeouts as a pitching staff on Thursday night. The most hits the RailRiders have tallied in a single-game this year is 19 against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on April 28. The strikeout total did set a new single-game high. The most strikeouts in a single-game this season was 16, something they did twice on May 11 against Syracuse and April 23 in Buffalo. The most hits in a single-game in franchise history is 27, set May 31, 1998 against Toledo. The most strikeouts in a single-game in franchise history is 22, set August 19, 2016 against Pawtucket.

ON DECK – The RailRiders return home on Tuesday, June 28 to face the Buffalo Bisons. It's "Twosday" at PNC Field. Get 2-for-1 lawn or bleacher seats online only and enjoy 52 Landshark Lager tallboys for two hours after gates open, presented by PrimoHoagies and The River.

AROUND THE ORGANIZATION – The New York Yankees (52-19) fell 3-1 to the Houston Astros yesterday. Giancarlo Stanton smashed a solo home run for the only Yankees run. Gerrit Cole matched up with Cristian Javier in day baseball today at 1:05 PM... The Somerset Patriots (42-25) lost 5-2 to the Hartford Yard Goats. Aroldis Chapman threw a scoreless top of the seventh and struck out one batter in his first rehab appearance. Adam Warren gets the start tonight at 7:05 PM... The Hudson Valley Renegades (34-33) dropped a tight contest to the Winston-Salem Dash 2-1 on Friday. Beck Way allowed just one run on one hit in 5.2 IP, walking two and striking out five. LAST TIME OUT: Wesneski gutted his way through five innings, surrendering four runs (three earned) on eight hits across five innings. He did not factor into the decision as Tim Locastro gave the RailRiders the lead with a home run in the eighth.

BA KNOWS: Baseball America's midseason scouting report update of Wesneski reads: "The delivery changes Waldichuk made in 2021 have carried over this season and have shown up in greater fastball velocity, more consistent command and control and overall consistency in his arsenal. His sweeping slider has been excellent this season as well, and his changeup has also improved. Specifically, Waldichuk has done a better job utilizing his lower half in his delivery, which has helped him improve his command as well as the quality of his pitches."

SAM SAYS: Yankees director of pitching Sam Briend had this to say about Wesneski in late-April: "Hayden's awesome. I mean, obviously, you look at him from just a general pitching package, you love the pitch package. He's got a four-seam, he's got a two-seam, a slider, a change-up, a cutter. He has weapons all over the place and he pounds the zone."
